COVID SAFETY

During our Principal Sunday service at 11:00 AM, everyone in attendance must wear a mask.

At all other times, fully vaccinated individuals are welcome to either wear a mask or not, purely at their election.

Individuals who have not been fully vaccinated are kindly asked to wear a mask inside the church at all times.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Please observe 6 feet of distance from those not in your immediate household.

EUCHARIST PREPARATION

- If seated near the center aisle, wait to be invited by an usher into the single Communion line. If seated on the side, walk to the back and an usher will guide you into the Communion line.
- Line up on a floor-marked sticker in the central aisle. A hand sanitizing station will be near the front of the line for optional use.
- Step forward and stand before the priest when it is your turn.

RECEIVING

- Receive the host on your flat palms.
- If worshipping at the 11 AM service, step aside to a floor-marked sticker for consuming the host. Lower your mask to consume and then replace your mask.
- Return to your pew via side aisle.
- Blessings will be contactless.

OFFERINGS

- For in-person offerings, please use the stationary offering plates (a) at the front of the center aisle when coming forward for Communion, or (b) at the back of the church when departing the service. You can also donate online.
