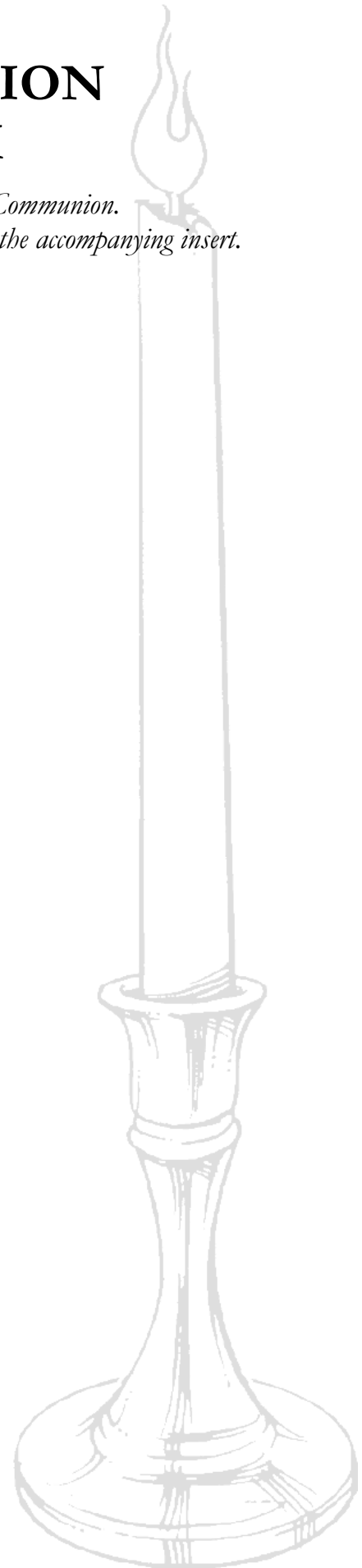

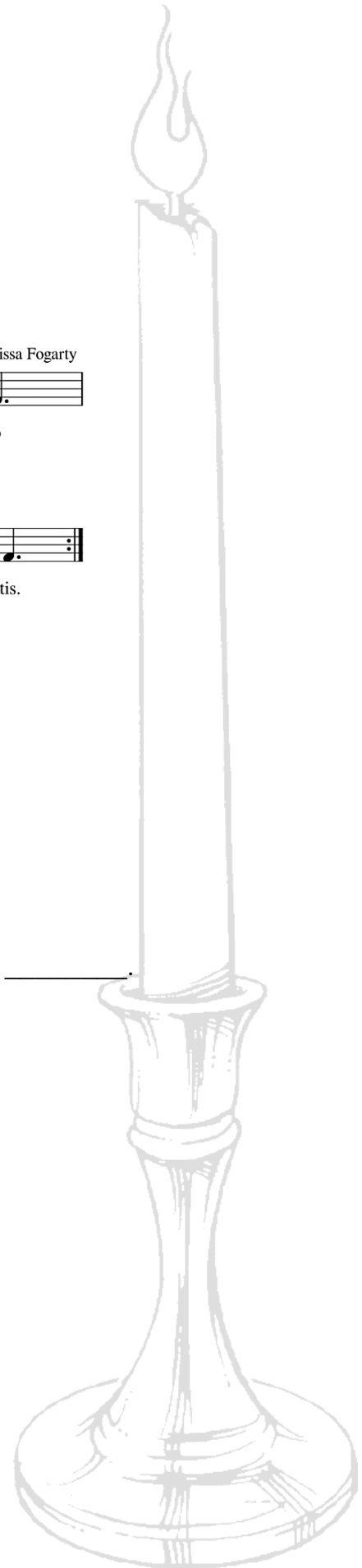

People **May we also come to share in your heavenly kingdom.**

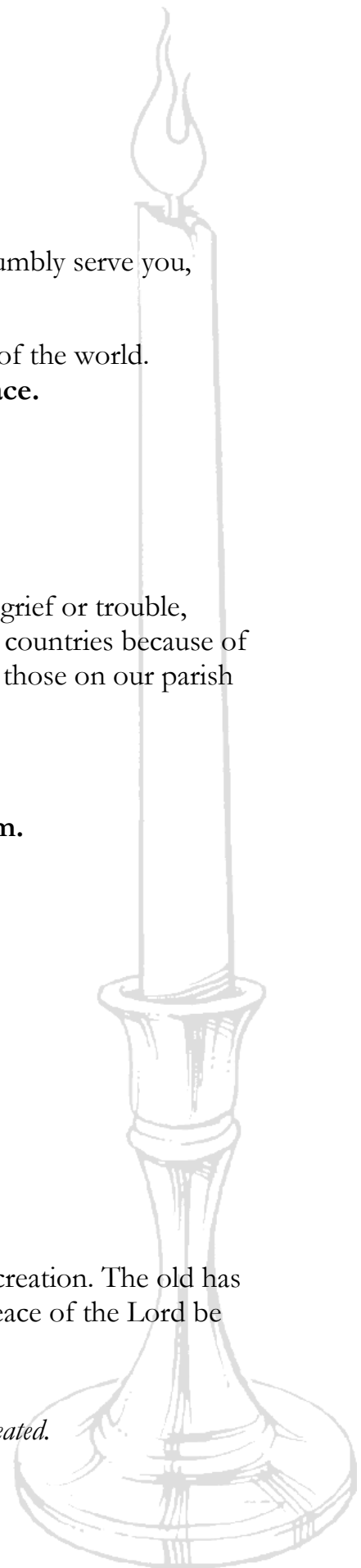
Leader We pray in silence for our own needs....

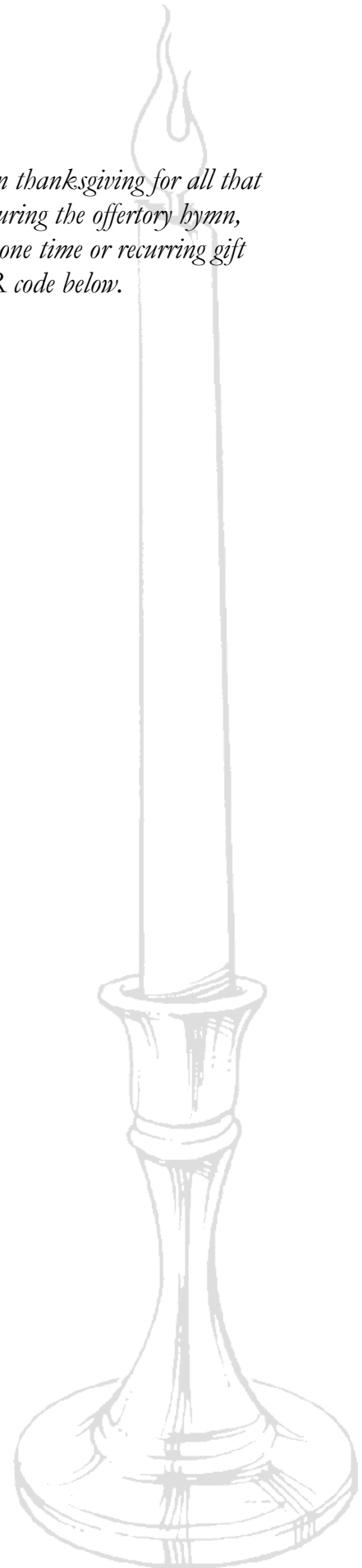
Celebrant Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

source of life and fountain of mercy.

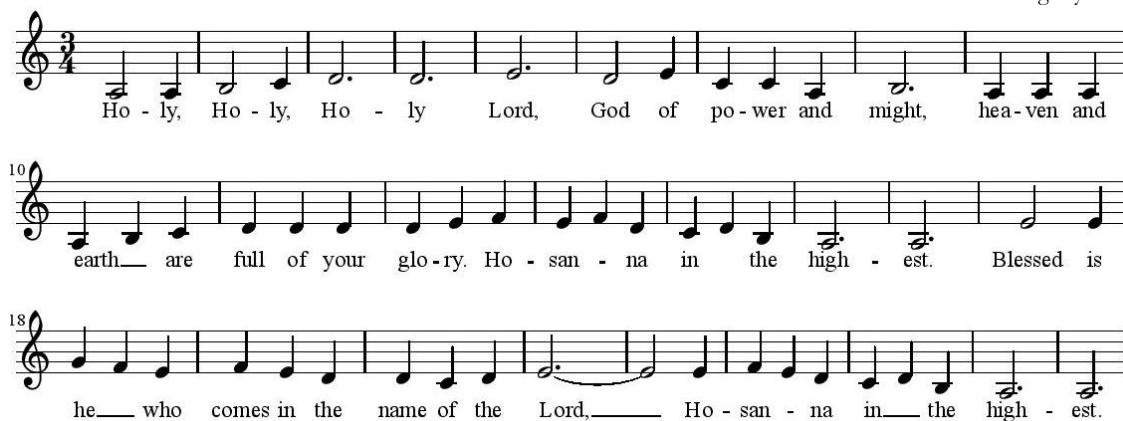
You have filled us and all creation with your blessing

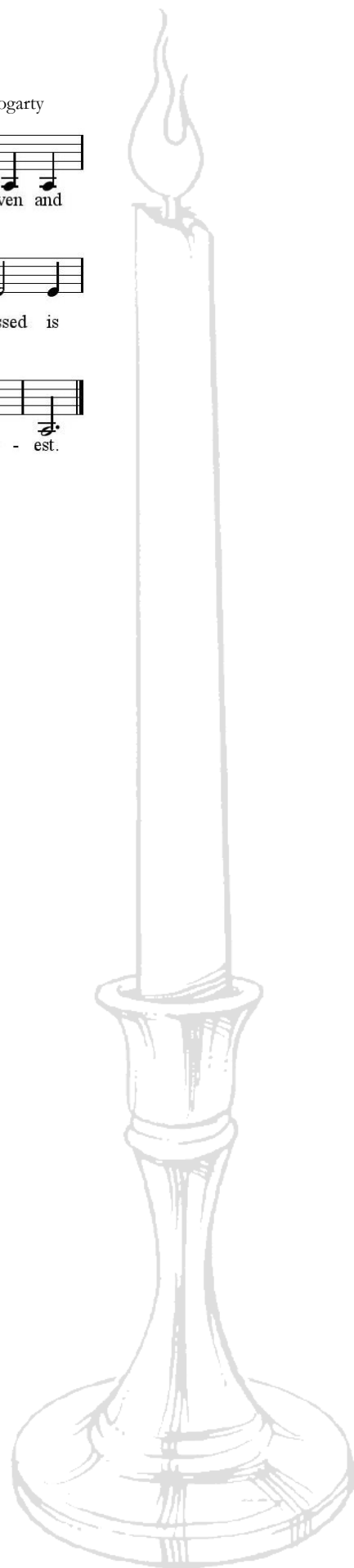

Celebrant Blessed are you, gracious God,

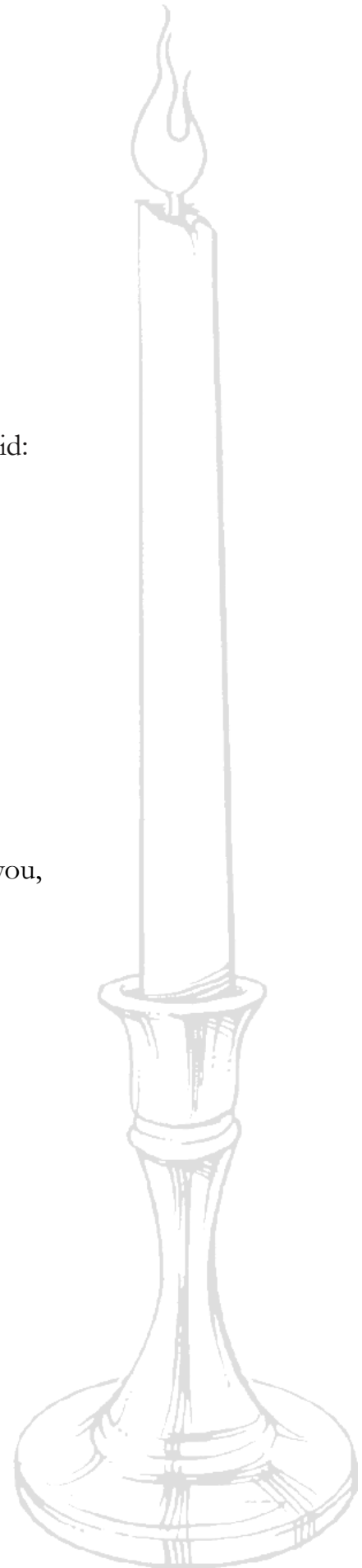
And we offer our sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving to you,

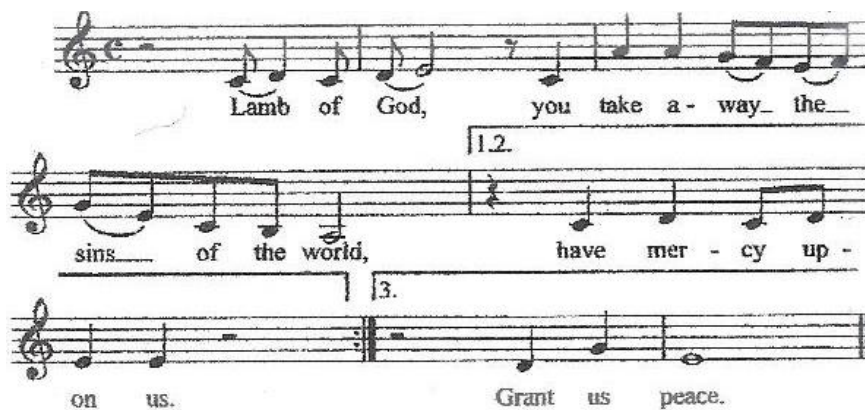
And now, as our Savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to say,

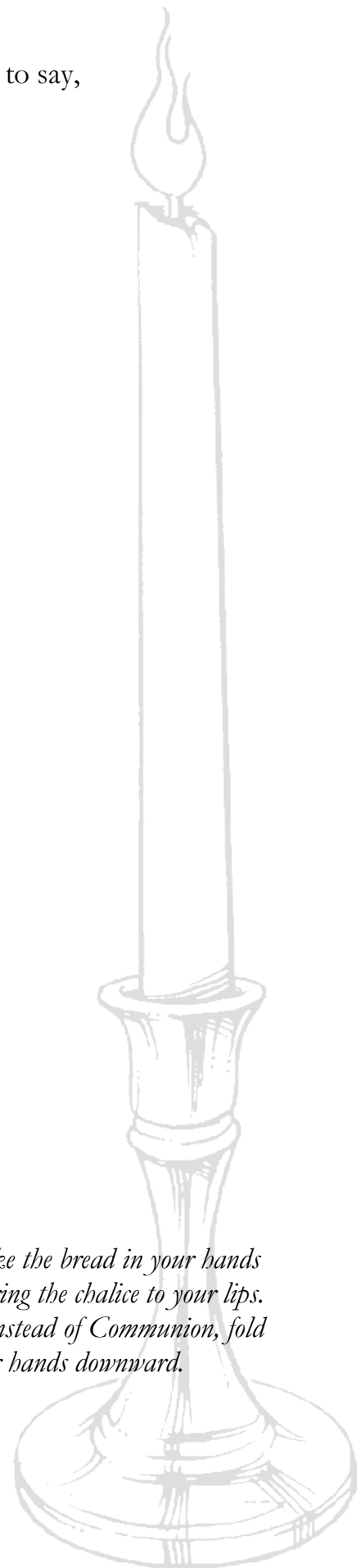

INVITATION TO COMMUNION

Celebrant The gifts of God for the People of God.

Please stand in a semi-circle around the altar to receive Communion. You may take the bread in your hands and then take a sip of wine from the chalice, guiding the chalice bearer's hand to bring the chalice to your lips. Or you may intinct (dip the wafer into the wine). If you wish to receive a blessing instead of Communion, fold your arms across your chest. If you would like a gluten-free wafer, fold your hands downward.
