COVID SAFETY

 - DO maintain 6 ft of distance from others.
 - Don't chat at check-in or departure; it causes dangerous crowding.
 - Don't remove your mask to make yourself heard; speak more loudly.

EUCHARIST PREPARATION

- Wait to be invited by an usher into the single Communion line.
- Line up on a floor-marked sticker in the central aisle. A hand sanitizing station will be near the front of the line.
- Step forward and stand before the priest when it is your turn. We will not be using the Communion rails.

OFFERINGS

- For in-person offerings, please use the stationary offering plates at the back of the church at the end of the service. You can also donate online.

RECEIVING

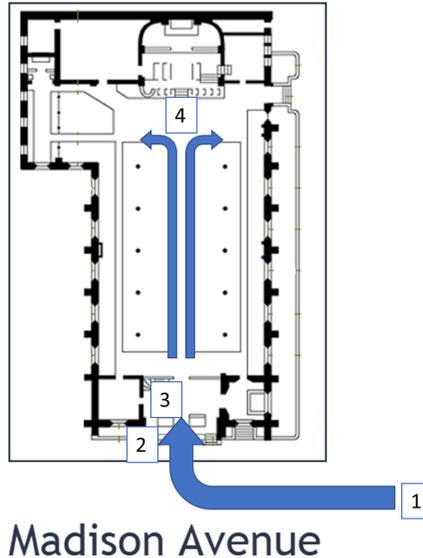
- Receive the host on your flat palms. Step aside to a floor-marked sticker for consuming the host. Lower your mask to consume. Replace your mask immediately. (Do not remove your mask in front of the clergy or ushers.)
- Return to your pew via side aisle.
- Blessings will be contactless.

DEPARTURE

- To depart the service, walk forward and around to the side aisle (in the same fashion for receiving Communion). Follow the arrows along the floor to exit.

Entrance Flow

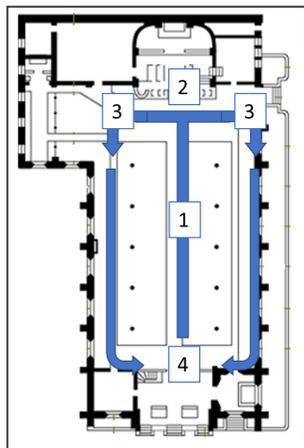
1. 6 ft apart, wear masks
2. Temperature check
3. Ushers collect contact details
4. Seating (one group per pew, every other pew from front to back)

Communion Flow

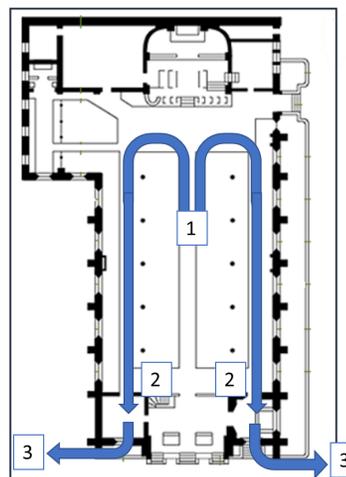
1. Maintain social distancing in Communion line

4. Return to your pew maintaining social distancing
